Clearfell Harvesting Report – Oak Bridge – December 2021

Summary

- Gross revenue for the month is **\$340,962.94**
- Costs for the month are **\$271,052.50**
- Net income for the month is **\$69,910.44**
- Tonnes harvested for the month is **2,725.22**
- Net income per tonne for the month is **\$25.65**
- Area cleared for the month is **3.5** hectares

The project performance to date is set out below:

- Project gross revenue to date is **\$11,830,938.98**
- Project costs to date are **\$8,418,872.99**
- Project net income to date is **\$3,412,065.99**
- Tonnes harvested to date is **84,477.07**
- Net income per tonne to date is **\$40.39**

- Total forest area is **193.8** hectares, approximate hectares cleared to date is **109.4** hectares.

The total forest area reflects all net stocked areas regardless of age class or previous roadline volumes.

NB: Measured harvest areas are estimated monthly and reconciled with satellite imagery prior to valuations, they are subject to change and should be used as a guide only.

Revenue

Log Sales

Gross income for the month was **\$340,962.94** with an average sale price over all grades of **\$125.11** per tonne.

December 2021 - Log Markets, Hawkes Bay

The December export prices have slipped \$2.64/Jas m³ on average. The decrease has affected the pruned grades slightly more.

Radiata log inventories on the main Chinese ports we monitor have decreased to 4.54Mm³, with daily offtake remaining solid at 80Km³ per day. Inventory is expected to remain elevated through December and into January then move lower as arrivals of New Zealand log cargos diminish.

Over January all major supply sources into China are expected to be down on normal, with a recent ban on Siberian non-containerised logs and lumber and a wider ban on Russian log imports come into force in January 2022. This will remove 3–4Mm³ from the log market over 2022. Also reports are that the EU beetle damaged spruce volumes will be down significantly as the rate of infestation has decreased along with strong local European demand. We are hoping we have seen the bottom of the market – the China wholesale domestic log market has flattened which is a good signal for short term price stability with the USD CFR sale price and the domestic selling price now closely aligned.

Both the oil and freight markets have made a small recovery over December. Spot rates moved briefly down into the high \$30's primarily driven by the huge reduction in harvesting and lack of cargos. Looking forward, the freight rates will be an important driver in our market in 2022. This will be hugely affected by the demand from the iron ore and coal markets dominated by China by the larger Cape and Panamax vessel classes.

The USD has strengthened against the NZD since the end of October and the recent spread of the Omicron variant has intensified fears the world is not out of the Covid woods. This has dampened the demand for riskier currencies and is good news for New Zealand exporters and forest owners.

Domestic pruned log prices have settled flat this quarter due to concerns relating to the slowdown in harvesting affecting production.

Grade Recovery

Grade out turn for December is as follows:

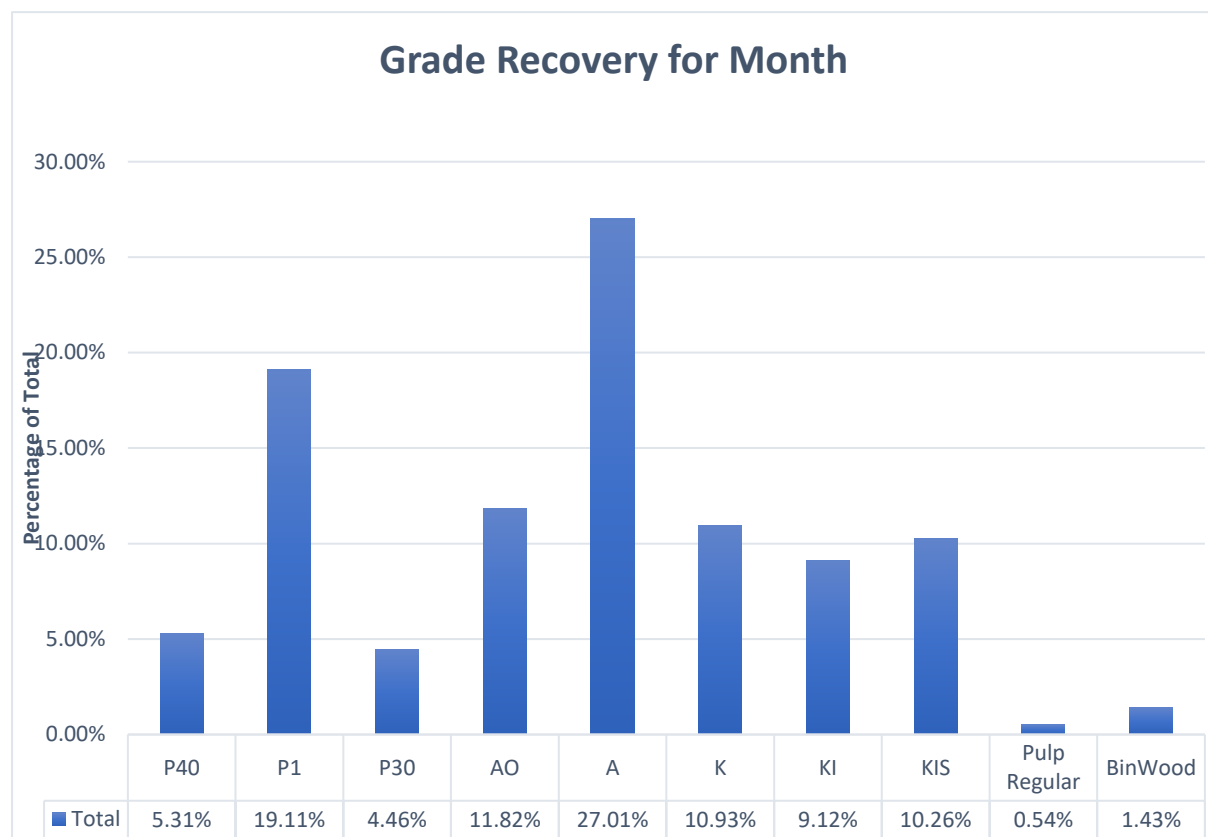


Chart 1: Grade Recovery for Month

Pruned recovery for December comprised 29% of overall sales volume, 19% of which was sold as domestic pruned grades.

High quality export sawlog (AO, A and K grades) made up 50% of the total production volume, with lower quality export (KI and KIS grades) comprising 19% of volume.

The remaining 2% of production was made up of domestic pulp and binwood.

Expenditure

Harvesting

The total logging cost for the month was **\$115,949.36**, an average of **\$42.55** per tonne.

Harvest expenditure for the month is summarised below in Table 1:

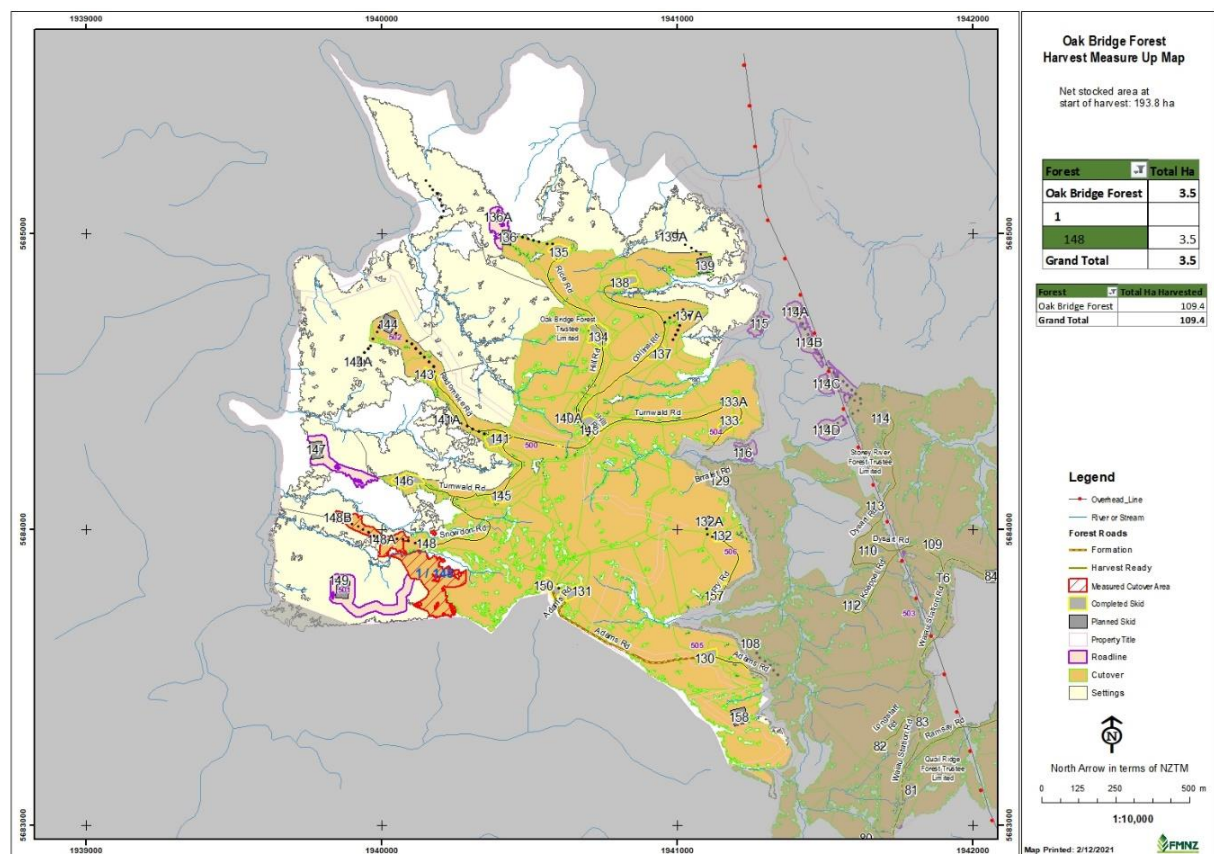

Establishment costs are for transportation of the harvest crews' containers, carriage and reels to Turnwald Road. This is an internal transfer and was undertaken by a Hiab truck.

During December, the harvest crew continued ground-based harvesting of a corridor off Setting 148 on Snowdon Road.

Harvesting operations continued to operate at capped harvest production levels in December. Overall caps on production were calculated on the available workdays in December and the crews stopped work for the Christmas break on the 17th of December. Return to work is planned for 17th of January 2022.

Cartage

Cartage is managed by Harvest Logistics Ltd, who organise the despatch and supply of log trucks into the forest.

The total cartage expense for the month was **\$90,248.57** which is an average unit rate of **\$33.12** per tonne.

The average cart rate for December inclusive of weighbridge, trailer lifting and trans-shipping fees is **\$33.69** per tonne.

Trailer lifting costs are for use of the public gantry to reload trailers for loads delivered outside the normal hours of the facility provided by the Napier Port.

Trans-shipping is the accumulating of logs from completed settings which could not be made up into full packets and moving these logs to the current setting for loadout and sale. The logs normally number 10 logs of this and 12 logs of that but are still product for sale.

Earthworks during December was predominantly on the construction of Snowden Road from Landing 145 to 148 including the construction of pads. Work was also completed on Landing 144 on Radomske Road and maintenance was undertaken on Turnwald Road to facilitate harvest operations.

Planned Activities for January 2022

The harvest crew will continue in Setting 148 and then move to Setting 141 while Snowden Road is being constructed to Setting 149.

The orange cumulative line measures actual performance against the forecast budget.

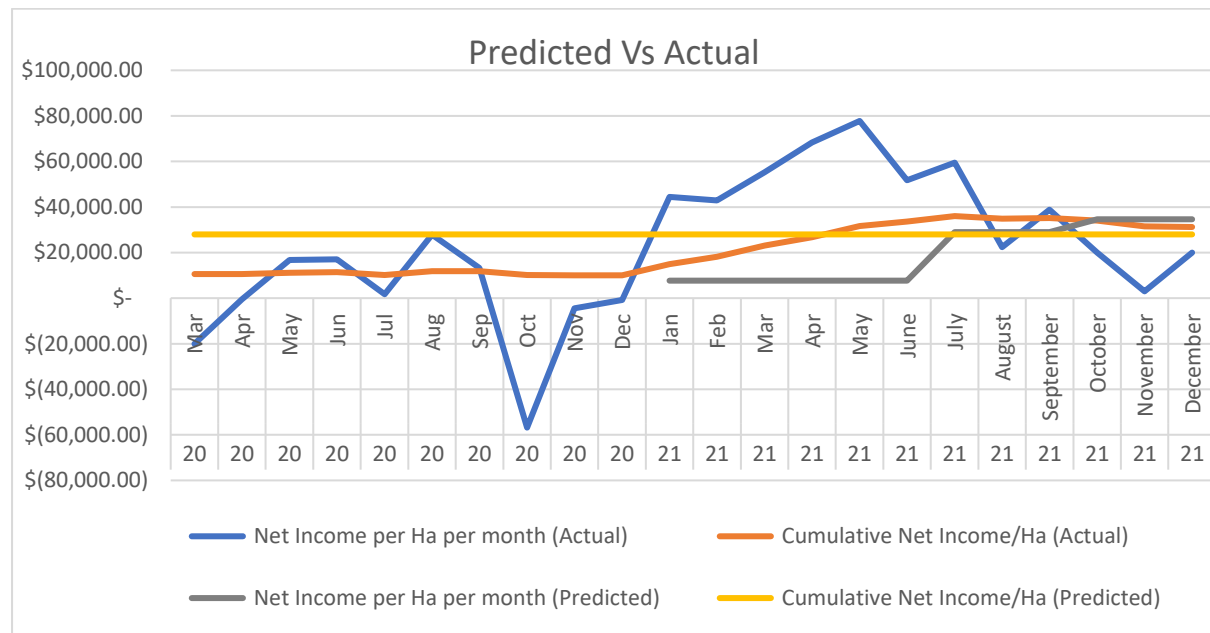


Chart 2: Actual vs Predicted
